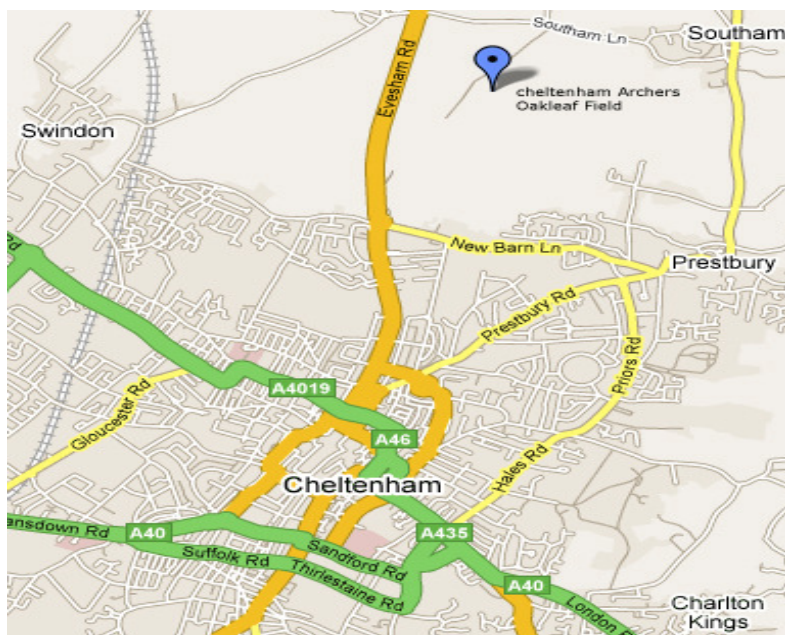


HOW TO GET THERE

Location / Directions

- Cheltenham Archers Club Ground is located at Oakleaf Field, Southam

From M5 J11 A40 Westbound (sp Cheltenham).
Follow signs for Cheltenham Racecourse. Entrance via Racecourse car park gate.
Or at Roundabout for Racecourse Entrance, Take exit SP A435 Evesham.
At Traffic Lights turn right onto Southam Lane.
Grounds are 0.5miles on your right, Just after Railway bridge,
Entrance via Racecourse car park gate.
