

Cotswold Head to Head Rules

1. With the exception of the B5, competitors will shoot the shortest distance of the Bristol/Hereford/York that they have used to qualify for the H2H. The B5's will shoot 15yds.
2. Boys and Girls will compete in the same competition, therefore all those competing for example in the B3 will compete against each other, there will only be separate categories for recurve and compound.
3. Competitors will be ranked on the basis of their 10 dozen score and the draw will be seeded such that highest ranked compete against lowest ranked etc. (standard H2H format). Those juniors shooting 'National Rounds' will also be included in the competition and ranked accordingly.
4. Each round match will consist of 6 arrows, 10 zone scoring, in the event of a draw there will be a single arrow shoot off, closest to the middle goes through.
5. When there is a single archer left in each distance (B1, B2, B3 etc), the final will be between all of those archers. There will be prizes for the first 3 archers.
6. Opponents will shoot on the same target and the GNAS time applies.
7. Winners of each match MUST report the result (scores) to the organizer within 5 mins of the end being scored, or they will be eliminated.
